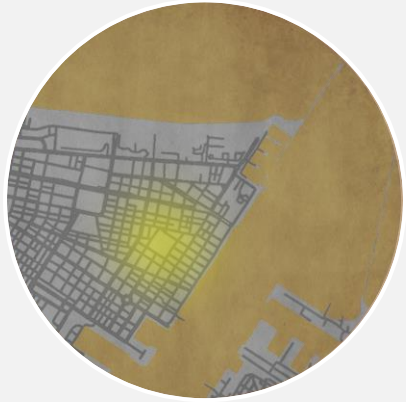


Ferial Garden as part of Port Said

The interaction between foreigners would be clearly through the balconies.

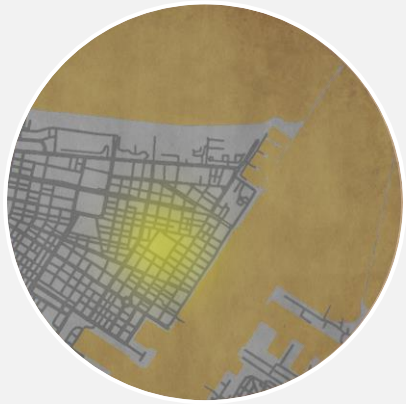
From the eyes of taracinas

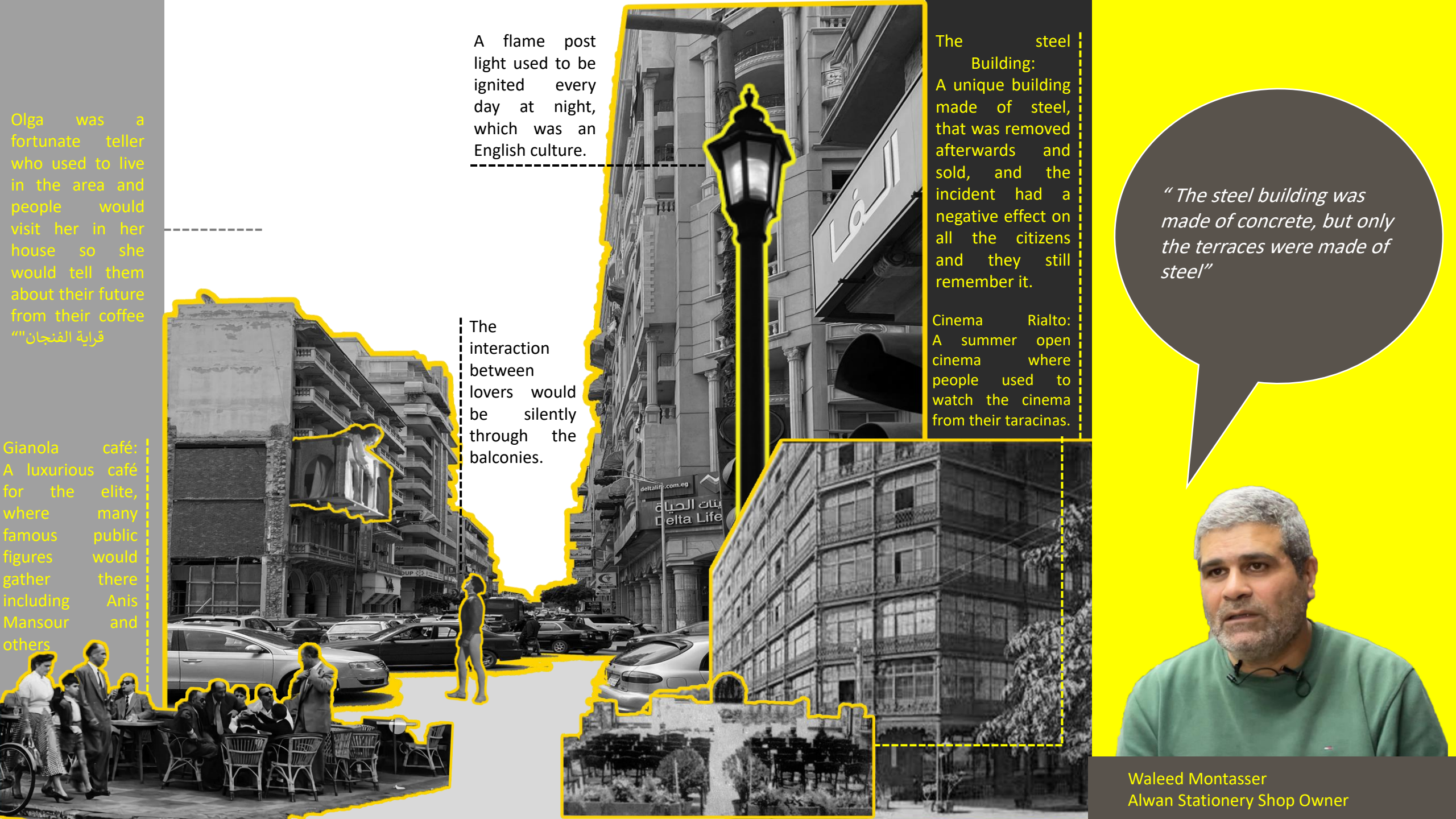
The steel Building: A unique building made of steel, that was removed afterwards and sold, and the incident had a negative effect on all the citizens and they still remember it.
